Emergency Fuel Cost Recovery Charge From 19 Dec 2007

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that effective 19 December, 2007 CMA CGM has filed in our governing tariff for cargo moving from Asia to the United States (CMDU043), an emergency fuel cost recovery charge.

Since September, the cost of bunker fuel has increased by 29%. Unfortunately, CMA CGM is no longer able to absorb these increases in costs. As a result, we have filed the following which applies to all tariff rates and contract rates which do not otherwise preclude the application of such a charge:

20'	USD 160 per container
40'	USD 200 per container
40'HC	USD 225 per container
45'	USD 255 per container

The emergency fuel cost recovery charge will not apply to tariff and contract rates which are already subject to a floating bunker charge.
